**RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH DIRECTOR TO  
APPLY FOR AND SIGN THE MEDICARE PROVIDER APPLICATION AND SUBMIT  
ANY DOCUMENTATION RELATED TO BECOME A MEDICARE PROVIDER**

**WHEREAS**, The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services Medi-CARE Provider application sets forth the conditions and requirements that Plumas County must meet in order to be reimbursed for federal and state funds available pursuant to Title XVIII of the Social Security Act for covered services rendered to Medi-CARE beneficiaries; and

**WHEREAS**, Plumas County Behavioral Health will make services available to Medi-CARE beneficiaries residing in Plumas County and the Provider application requires that a designee be authorized to apply for and sign the application; and

**WHEREAS**, the need to have Medicare services for Plumas County is critical to the safety and security of Plumas County residents and it is to the County's benefit to authorize the Plumas County Behavioral Health Director to take such actions as to benefit the residents in need of Medicare services.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Plumas County Board of Supervisors as follows:

Authorize the County Behavioral Health Director to apply for and electronically sign the application and any documents associated with the Medi-CARE Provider application and authorize the County Behavioral Health Director to sign any further documents pertaining to this agreement as the Board's designee.




