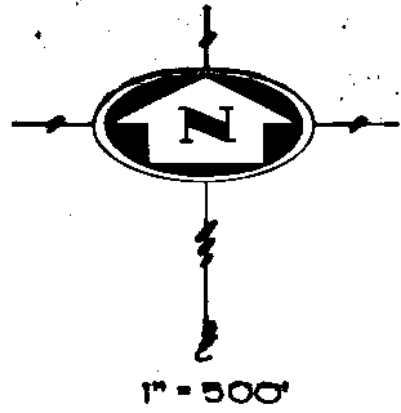
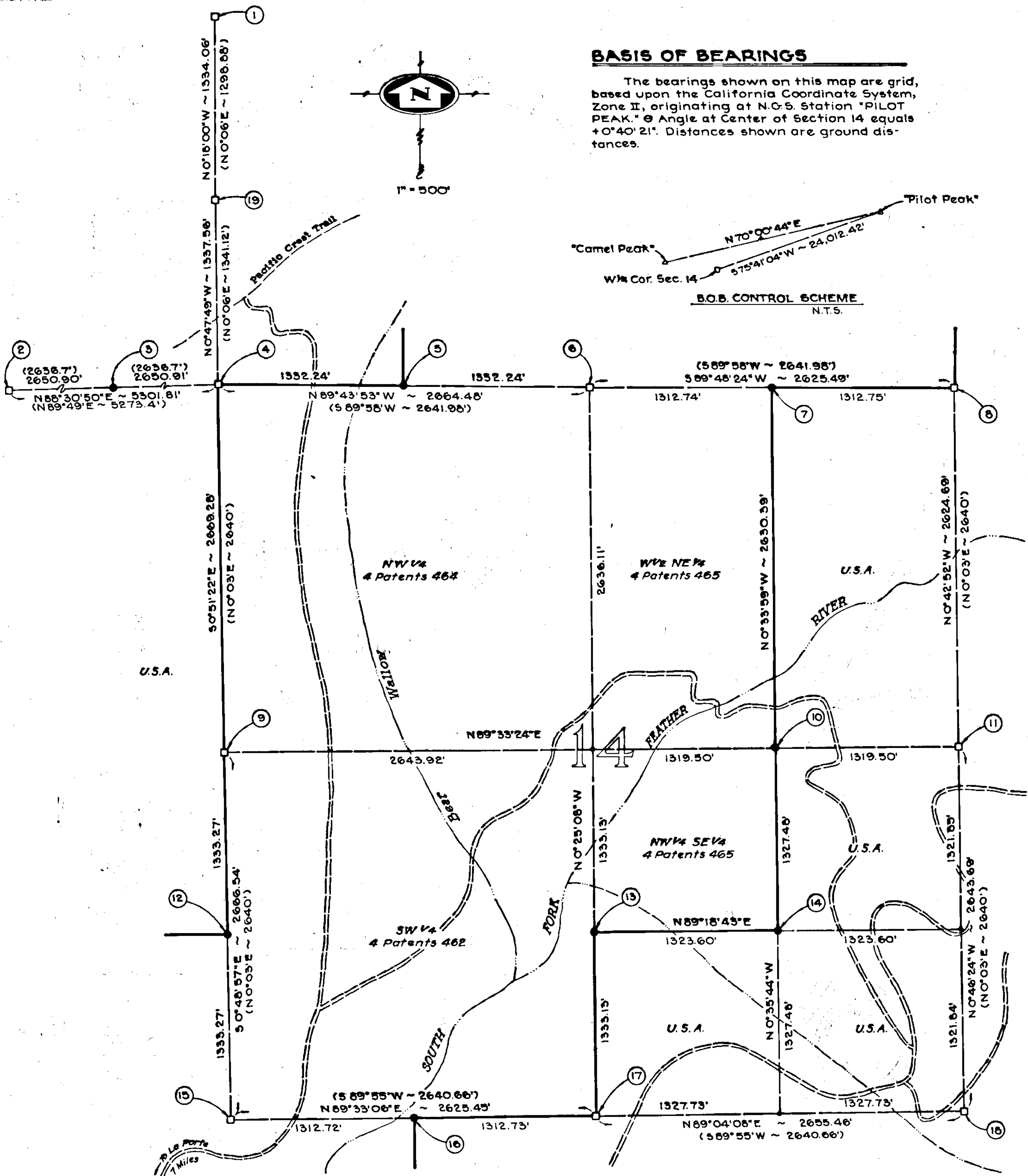
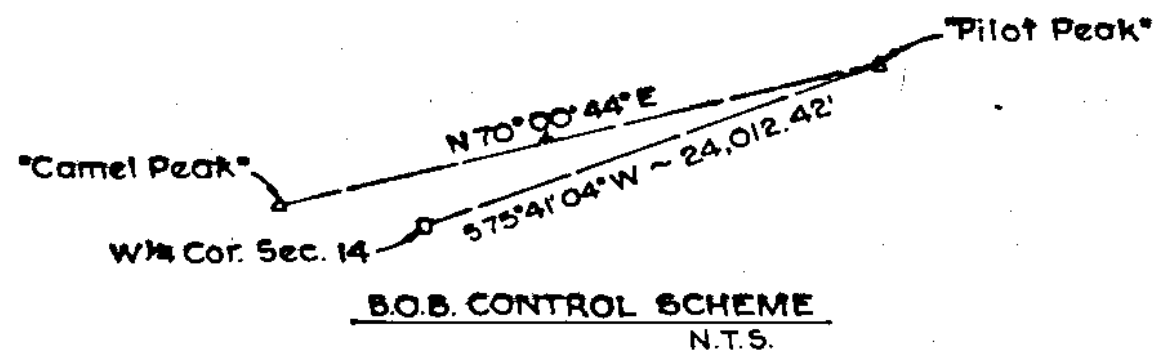




BASIS OF BEARINGS
