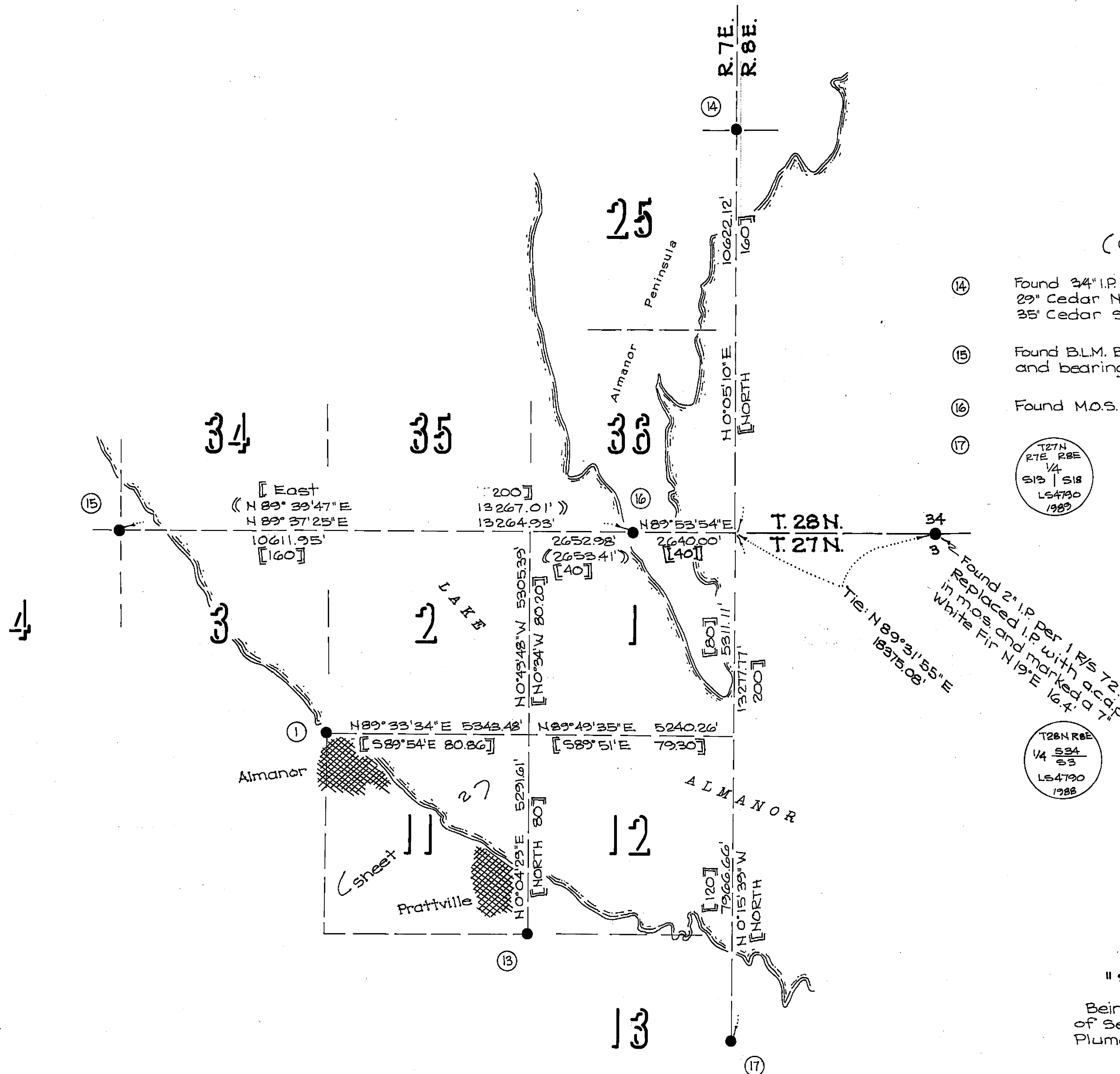

- (15) Found B.L.M. B.C.I.P. & 1 1/2" I.P. tagged "LS 3202" in M.O.S. and bearing trees per 6 R/S 145
- (16) Found M.O.S. per 6 R/S 145, set rebar and cap "LS 4790"
