

NOTICE OF ELECTION AND CANDIDATE FILING INFORMATION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, in accordance with the provisions of the California Elections Code, that the Presidential Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, March 5, 2024. Plumas County VOTES BY MAIL. If you are registered to vote, a VOTE BY MAIL ballot will be mailed to you 29 days prior to Election Day. If you have not received your VOTE BY MAIL ballot by February 16, 2024, call 530-283-6256 or 1-866-676-VOTE for a replacement ballot. All returned VOTE BY MAIL ballot identification envelopes must have the voters' signature and Plumas County residence address included to be counted. Postage is provided for you.

The Plumas County Courthouse located at 520 Main Street in Quincy will be open Monday - Friday, 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. and on Tuesday, March 5, 2024, Election Day, from 7:00 a.m. - 8:00 p.m. to obtain, exchange, replace or return a VOTE BY MAIL ballot. Personally delivered ballots must be delivered by 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, March 5, 2024. VOTE BY MAIL ballots must be postmarked on or before March 5, 2024, and received by the county elections office no later than March 12, 2024.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that forms for eligible candidates filing for elective offices may be obtained from the Plumas County Clerk Elections Department at 520 Main Street Room 102, Quincy. Judges Notice of Intention of Candidacy must be filed from October 30, 2023 through November 8, 2023. Candidates' Declarations shall be accepted for filing from November 13, 2023 through December 8, 2023, at 5:00 p.m. unless extended. Petitions for Signatures in Lieu of Filing Fees shall be accepted for filing from September 14, 2023 through November 8, 2023 at 5:00 p.m.
