Join a Workshop and Learn More About the Grant Guidelines

Eligible activities permitted under the Program include:
(1) Reimbursement and/or purchase of equipment and supplies (i.e., machinery and tools, office equipment and software, and furniture and fixtures) and (2) future payments of up to 6 months of Operating Capital expenses in support of the business (i.e., payroll, insurance, utilities, and rent/mortgage). **Maximum grant award amount is \$22,700.**

**The Grant Application is anticipated
to be released on August 12, 2024. Grants will be
awarded on a first-come, first-served rolling basis.**
